The Parish Council was informed that PC Vaughan Marks would shortly be retiring and PC Elliott confirmed that he to would retire at the end of July. Following concern raised over how PC Elliott would be replaced, the Parish Council agreed that to write to Cheshire Police.

Following concern raised over road safety outside Ashton Hayes Primary School, PC Elliott confirmed that he would visit local residents to reiterate the danger of parking outside and in the area of the school on Church Road.
